Memorandum

To: All Pre-Registration Pharmacists

IMPORTANT ISSUES TO NOTE DURING VOCATIONAL TRAINING (PRE_REGISTRATION TRAINING)

During pre-registration training all pre-registration pharmacists must observe the following;

- 1. First Aid training must be done within the first five months of pre-registration training and a first aid certificate must be submitted together with the six months assessment reports.
- 2. The First Aid training must be done at an approved organization which gives forty hours of training. Any other training with less than forty hours is not acceptable.
- 3. Only A4 sized training reports are acceptable. Do not use the A5 size forms in the Pre-Registration Training Guidelines hand book.
- 4. Rotations done at pharmaceutical wholesalers, for example at Natpharm, Pharmaceuticals Chemical Distributors (PCD) etc.) are not acceptable.
- 5. Training must only be done at **approved** premises and under the continuous supervision of registered supervisors.
- 6. Pre-Registration Pharmacists are not allowed to perform "locums" at any time.
- 7. The first level (level 1B) of the Professional Qualifying Examination is written three (3) months into pre-registration training and second level (level II) of the Professional Qualifying Examination is written nine (9) months into pre-registration training.
- 8. Assessment reports must be submitted in the prescribed forms.
- 9. The final assessment reports **must** be submitted to Council a month before completion of pre-registration training.
- Late submission of assessment report will attract a late submission fee charged per month.
- 11. Must have accrued at least **30 points** (**CPD**) which should be submitted on completion of pre-registration training.
